

RESULTS:

FIREARMS

Item 19

- The pistol was test fired using the submitted magazine and was found to be functional. Images of a cartridge case fired in the pistol were entered in and compared to NIBIN. No potential associations were made at this time.

Item 20

- The items were removed from the water and the pistol was oiled. The pistol was test fired using the submitted magazine and hand chambering and was found to be functional; however, the pistol frequently failed to cycle properly. The water was discarded.
- Images of a cartridge case fired in the pistol were entered in and compared to NIBIN. No potential associations were made at this time.

AMMUNITION

Item 20.1

- The cartridge was not further examined at this time.

REMARKS:

Items 20, 20.1 and tests generated from Items 19 and 20 will be retained for further analysis.

Your agency will be notified of any future NIBIN results.
